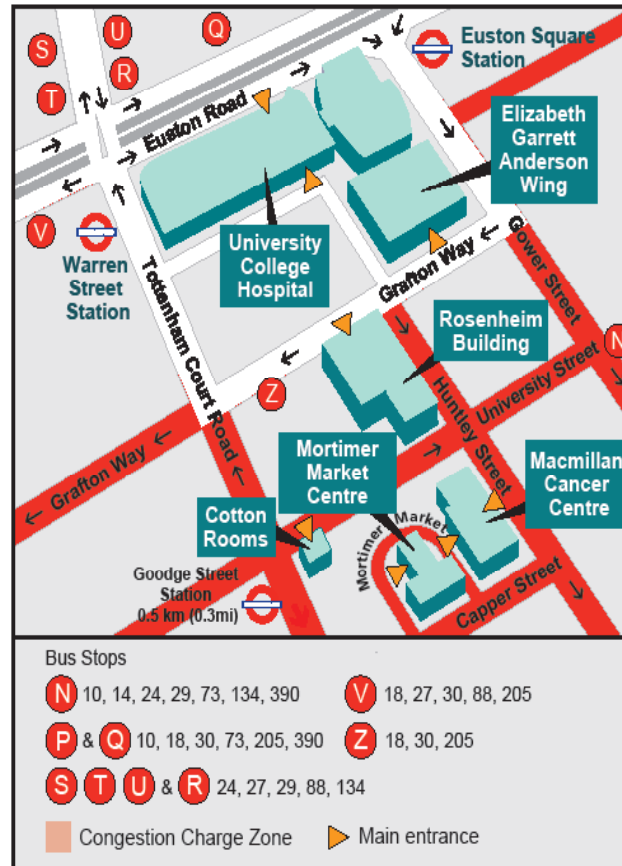

Your Pathway Co-ordinator

Children and Young People's Cancer Service



Introduction

The Haematology and Oncology Pathway Co-ordinators work as part of the Children and Young People's Cancer Service here at University College Hospital. All patients under the care of the Children and Young People's Cancer Service can access a Pathway Co-ordinator.

Pathway Co-ordinators work alongside the clinical team which includes Doctors, Clinical Nurse Specialists, Ward Nurses and any other professionals involved in your care, whether they are from University College Hospital, your local hospital or your community team.

Pathway Co-ordinators offer administrative support to you and your team, and oversee your treatment pathway. They will communicate regularly with your local hospital services when needed, ensuring that they're aware of any updates in your care.

You will be given the contact details of one of our Pathway Co-ordinators, who are contactable from Monday to Friday, 09:00 til 17:00. They should be your first point of call for all general, non-urgent advice.

Where do the Pathway Co-ordinators work?

Pathway Co-ordinators move around University College Hospital and the University College Hospital Macmillan Cancer Centre to visit staff, patients and their families. They can come and see you when you:

- Are being treated as an inpatient on the ward or as an outpatient in Day Care
- Attend an outpatient appointment or come in for investigations.

How can the Pathway Co-ordinator help me?

Your Pathway Co-ordinator is here to make your time as a patient at University College Hospital as easy as possible and they're happy to answer any questions you have.

Examples of ways your Pathway Coordinator can help include:

- Helping you to get in touch with any hospital staff or services you may wish to speak to
- Arranging or changing an outpatient appointment or a scan/investigation appointment
- Organising tests and investigations
- Keeping your details up-to-date
- Booking an interpreter to be with you at your outpatient appointment
- Advising you on arranging hospital transport
- Helping with booking accommodation.
