Course Overview:

Many dental patients' experience a high level of anxiety or may have a phobia about receiving dental treatment which can prevent them from accessing the necessary treatment required to ensure that they achieve good oral hygiene and are dentally fit. However, today many practices offer treatment using a range of dental sedation techniques enabling patients' top access dental treatment.

Learning Outcomes:

- Demonstrate both your clinical and theoretical knowledge related to Conscious Sedation Dental Nursing through obtaining the NEBDN Certificate in Dental Sedation and the completion of the Record of Competence.

- Be able to have a basic understanding of oral and intranasal sedation which can be built upon by undergoing further training.

• Qualification Options:

- **Certificate in Dental Sedation Nursing** - for dental nurses working with all types of Dental Sedation and as an initial qualification for those undertaking further training and experience to work with patients under Oral and/or trans-mucosal sedation.
- **Award in Inhalation Sedation Dental Nursing** - This is suitable for dental nurses working within a practice offering inhalation sedation.
- **Award in Intravenous Sedation Dental Nursing** – This is suitable for dental nurses working within a practice offering intravenous sedation and as an initial qualification for those undertaking further training and experience to work with patients under Oral and/or trans-mucosal sedation.
