- a **specialist centre for services** currently at the Eastman Dental and the Royal National Throat, Nose and Ear Hospitals.

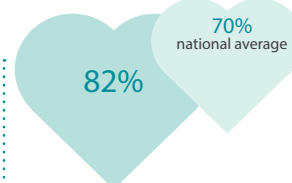
